## Hamilton County Challenges

Hamilton County and our surrounding areas suffer from a huge gap in health equity. Social determinants of health, such as economic, educational, environmental, and social constraints, greatly contribute to health disparities. Life expectancy at birth varies by up to 20 years for residents in bordering neighborhoods. Solving this problem will require new, proactive models, partnerships and prevention. However, it also requires something more.

We must also combat this problem through access, innovation, patient experience and doubling down on our strengths—expert care for women, cancer, cardiac, neurosciences and advanced surgery.

All these adjustments will provide an easier wayfinding experience for patients and families as well as streamline access to critical care.

## Where the Impact is Greatest

### Advanced Surgical Institute

On average, each of us will undergo an average of 9.2 surgical procedures in our lifetime. As a patient facing surgery you want the most talented team, best equipment and safest environments. You also want the least amount of pain, best outcomes and a chance to recover at home. This is the Good Samaritan Advanced Surgical Institute of the future. Already considered Cincinnati's most trusted leader in surgical care, this new facility will transform the patient experience and provide even greater access for our community.

The TriHealth/Mayfield Brain & Spine partnership provides our communities with the largest team of neuroscience professionals anywhere in Southwest Ohio. Advancement in technology, equipment, and facilities enable this team of trailblazers to provide world-class care for brain tumors, stroke and complex spine care. Through philanthropy, Good Sam was the first to introduce the da Vinci Robotic platform to the Cincinnati region, an advanced, minimally invasive surgical system. TriHealth's robotic surgery program is ranked in the top 1% nationally when it comes to the number of surgeries performed.

What's to come in the new center:

- State-of-the-art operating rooms (OR) and integration will allow surgeons to collaborate from anywhere in the ORs
- New hybrid rooms that will be the most versatile in the city
- An additional BiPlane room, allowing anterior/posterior images of the patient's brain
- Three new large rooms dedicated to neuro with the most updated neuro tables
- Continuation of the new PULSE system from Nuvasive, staying front-end innovators in the neurosurgical arena
- New technology will improve efficiency through workflow and turnaround time

## TriHealth Cancer and Blood Institute

The TriHealth Cancer and Blood Institute has grown to become the region’s largest and most comprehensive cancer program, serving more than 40% of all cancer patients across Greater Cincinnati.

TriHealth physicians detect cancer more than those at any other health care system in the region. In the previous year, 10,642 patients with cancer were treated at a Good Samaritan location. Between 2015 and 2050, TCBI predicts the total number of cancer cases to increase by almost 50%.

Philanthropic support has propelled Good Samaritan to be designated a Joint Commission Center of Excellence of Acute Leukemia. Along with this, Good Samaritan also holds the Joint Commission’s Gold Seal of Approval for Pancreatic Cancer and has earned their Patient Blood Management Certification.

Consistently among the list of what matters to patients and their families most is tailored and centralized cancer care: A single, trusted location that delivers the best physicians, caring nurses, innovative solutions and an environment



that offers hope and ease during the worst of times. This revamped center will better respond to the rising needs of our community while providing top-quality care in an integrated health system. It will include an expansion of chairs to accommodate more patients, new research and genetics offices, a growth of exam rooms from nine to 24, consolidation of all hematology and oncology, enhanced ease of access to the center and additional infusion chairs.

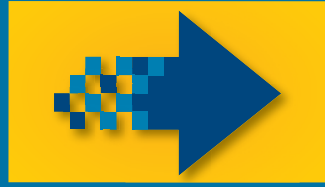
